Cadet Uniform Quick Reference



Wedgewood Blues—worn for ceremonies, parades & important events.



Working Blues—worn for day to day activities and most informal events.



No3 Field uniform -Multi-Terrain Pattern (MTP) Worn in the field for fieldcraft, shooting & other outdoor activities.



Civilian Dress—Squadron Polo Top
Worn instead of uniform for general activities
Worn by Junior Cadets until uniform issued.

Uniform and Care

All uniform should be kept clean & well kept (no loose threads/snags etc.) Shirts should be washed after each use either with a biological liquid or on a 60°C wash. Other items should be washed as labelled.

Beret:

Band Horizontal 25 mm above eyebrow. Badge over left eye. Mould using cold water.



Tie: Windsor knot 25mm at top – correct length

Is approximately to navel. Only worn with Wedgewood blue shirt.

Jumper: Worn in Cold weather, patches should be ironed with a cool iron.

Light blue Wedgewood Shirt (collar inside when wearing Jumper)

Shirt to be worn with creases in on each sleeve running from the centre of the epaulette to the cuff (depending on style).

On Female Shirts - As well as sleeves, front darts are to be pressed into the level of the second button & the rear darts down the full length of the shirt.

Dark Blue Working Shirt: (collar outside when wearing Jumper)

They are worn the same as Wedgewood, with creases in the same places and female pressed the darts. Sleeve may be rolled up in hot weather.

Trousers/Slacks: Sharp creases both front & back full length of trousers

Skirt: Hang naturally – Correct length – to middle of knee.

Shoes & Socks:

Socks: Black & above ankle. **Tights:** 15 Denier nearly black, no patterns.

Shoes & Boots—Clean and polished overall, welts cleaned with brush. No scuffs or dirt.

Males Shoes— highly polished toe caps .

Females Shoes— highly polished all round



Hair

Haircuts should always be tidy and presentable. Short hair should always be away from the ears & the collar of the shirt.

Haircuts should not be shorter than a No2 Cut.

Long Hair

Long hair must be worn in an approved style.

Brassard should be worn on the right arm.

Badges should be neatly sown on.

Use a warm iron on badges
